<p>What projects are anticipated in the next six months?</p>	<p>While these projects are currently anticipated, they may or may not move forward and others may or may not be added:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student Success Center</li> <li>• Health Outpatient Pavilion</li> <li>• Multidisciplinary Research Building 2</li> <li>• Long Range Development Plan</li> </ul>
<p>Are there traffic consultants that UCR has used in the past and/or recommend?</p>	<p>UCR does not recommend any specific traffic consultant. Any qualified consultant that proposing firm has a relationship with would be considered. Many environmental consultants under agreement to UCR have used in-house resources. Others have used Fehr &amp; Peers as a sub-consultant.</p>
<p>What range of sub-consultants need to be listed? Do we need to list for services usually provided by the project design teams?</p>	<p>List the range of sub-consultants that would be needed outside your organization to support a full range of environmental services.</p> <p>Specialty sub-consultants for technical areas typically provided by a project design team (e.g. geotechnical reports, civil surveys) do not need to be included.</p>
<p>Do sub-consultants need to prepare an Attachment B for submittal?</p>	<p>No they do not. However, sub-consultants do need to complete Attachment C.</p>
<p>Can the submittal be printed double-sided?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>Can brief bios be included in the proposal and full resumes be provided in an appendix or do the resumes need to be built into the SOQ?</p>	<p>Present the information/materials in the way that you feel will best represent and communicate your qualifications.</p>
<p>How many firms do you anticipate on selecting?</p>	<p>We intend to select one, but no more than three firms dependent on the number of projects projected to move forward in the next 6 months.</p>
<p>Are you specifically looking for a firm with UC experience? Could we include experience to show for non UC campuses?</p>	<p>We welcome all qualified firms. Please include any experience you feel supports your qualifications in accordance with the RFQ.</p>
