Only those bidders that have been determined to be prequalified will be eligible to submit a bid for the Project.

If a prospective bidder is determined by the University not to be prequalified, the prospective bidder may request a review by the University of California, Riverside. If any person or entity is not satisfied with the outcome of the prequalification, such person or entity may file an objection with the University of California, Riverside. Any such a request or objection must be submitted in writing and received by the University of California, Riverside, at the address for receipt of Prequalification Questionnaires listed on the Advertisement for Contractor Prequalification and for Bids **no later than 3 calendar days** after the date of the University's written notice regarding prequalification determination. The decision resulting from such review is final and is not appealable within the University of California. Any assertion that the outcome of the prequalification process was improper will not be grounds for a bid protest.

All information submitted for prequalification evaluation in response to Sections 3 and 16 and marked as "confidential" will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University of California will maintain its confidentiality unless (1) the University determines that it is required to release the information to a third party pursuant to the requirements of the California Public Records Act or (2) the University is required by court order to release the information to a third party pursuant to the requirements of the California Public Records Act. In the event that the University receives a request pursuant to the California Public Records Act and the University determines that it is required to disclose



information marked "confidential" by the provisions of the California Public Records Act, the University will notify the prospective bidder of the pending disclosure at least 72 hours prior to such disclosure so that the prospective bidder may seek a restraining order in advance of such disclosure. The University shall err on the side of transparency and will generally treat information provided by the prospective bidder that is not marked "confidential" as subject to disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act. Likewise, any decision by the University that any document is subject to disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act shall not prevent the University from making a subsequent determination that any document is not subject to disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act.

All other information submitted for prequalification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.
