<p>Is there any favoritism to the University's On-Call CEQA Consultants?</p>	<p>No. In accordance with established University procedures, UCR will review all submittals in response to the RFQ and will select the most qualified firm(s).</p>
<p>What if the Project Manager (PM) and staff have qualifications preparing environmental documents for University of California (UC), UCR, and/or educational facilities but from a different firm? Can that be noted under B.5 of the RFQ?</p>	<p>The University reserves the right to select a firm whose proposed PM/staff have related experience with UC, UCR, and/or educational experience.</p> <p>Please include a footer on projects that the PM/staff have worked on for those specific projects and note the specific roles/tasks involved in those projects.</p>
<p>Should the submittal include qualifications and scope of work, or just qualifications?</p>	<p>Please include ONLY qualifications. No scope of work or proposal and/or fees including hourly rate sheets are included in this submittal.</p>

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<p>Should fees be included if a proposal is included now?</p>	<p>No fees including hourly rate sheets are included in this submittal.</p>
<p>Will the page limitations be expanded to include the requested proposal and schedule along with the qualifications?</p>	<p>Although proposals and schedule are not included in this submittal, the page limitation has been expanded to 40 pages so that firms can include resumes.</p>
<p>Will the University extend the submittal deadline?</p>	<p>Due to the upcoming holidays, the University will extend the submittal deadline to Friday, January 10, 2020 at Noon.</p>
