The 2021 LRDP would guide long-range land use development of the students of the s	n the main UC Riverside campus for the next 15 years. Development under the 2021 LRDP is designed to accommodate a total enrollment of approximately 35,000 pment, open space preservation and improvements, multi-modal mobility planning, and infrastructure sustainability and resiliency efforts.
To accommodate the anticipated increase of approximately 11.078 students and 2,806 faculty and staff by academic year 2035/ additional academic buildings, support facilities, and student housing. The 2021 LRDP would provide on-campus or campus-co- following land use designations: Academics & Research, Campus Sunond, Land-hased Research, Connes Nane Research	35/2036, the 2021 LRDP proposes a net increase in development of approximately 3.7 million assignable square feet (approximately 6 million gross square feet) of ontrolled student housing for approximately 40 percent of the student population, equal to approximately 7.489 new on-ampus beds. The 2021 LRDP proposes the creation & Athletics, Student Neightonbode, Agricultural/Campus Research, UCR Botanic Garders, Campon Crest Gateway, and University Avenue Gateway.
The proposed 2021 LRDP is a campus wide plan to guide development, however, adoption of the proposed 2021 LRDP does no	conconstitutes a commitment to grave specific project. Rather, development under the 2021 LRDP would occur over time, based on campus needs and funding availability, vel, the review of campus development proposals is informed by a process that involves input from staff, faculty, and students (and the local community as appropriate).
