PROJECT FACTS

- Batchelor Hall was completed in 1965.
- Four Levels + Basement + Roof.
- > Type II-A Building.
- Occupancy Classification: Group B, Research Laboratory.
- Project Scope: Infrastructure Renovation.
- The main focus of the Batchelor Hall Renewal Project is the replacement and/or upgrade the building Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical, Conveyance, and Fire Protection Systems.
- This will need to be supported by Structural work (Concrete & Structural Steel), Roofing, Demolition, and Hazmat Abatement (among other things).

PROJECT FACTS

- Total Anticipated Construction Budget: \$14,067,474.
 - Bidders are asked to submit lump-sum proposals based on '100% Construction' documents issued by HDR, Inc. Proposals will be strictly '<u>Plans & Specs</u>'; no qualifications will be allowed on Subcontractor proposals.
 - Review the Scope Sheets for your Bid Package carefully.

PROJECT FACTS

- The project is divided into <u>FOUR</u> phases + a "prep" phase (Phase 0).
- Each phase has a duration of approximately 6 months each.
- Building will remain open and occupied during the entire construction period. Emergency egress must be maintained for all building occupants.
 The users of each respective phase will be temporarily relocated, <u>except</u> for the Phase I Metabolomics research area which will remain occupied. This area will need to be "protected in place" with functional utilities.
- Logistics, including access and egress, will be vitally important.

DIR Reminds the Public Works Community of \$2,000 Penalty Effective January 1

The Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) reminds the public works community that as of January 1, 2016, the penalty for lapsed public works contractor registration (in addition to the \$300 annual renewal fee) will increase from \$300 to \$2,000.

The term "public works contractor" applies to all businesses or sole operators subject to California's prevailing wage laws.

If you are a public works contractor with an expired registration but you have not bid or worked on any public works projects requiring registration as of July 1, 2015, you can renew your registration for this fiscal year without incurring any penalties.

If you believe your public works contractor registration is active, we encourage you to:

 Use the active contractor registration search tool to locate and confirm your active registration. (The best way to search is to fill out just the registration)

ARTICLE 2 BIDDER'S REPRESENTATIONS

2.1 Bidder, by making a Bid, represents that:

2.19 Bidder agrees that every contractor and subcontractors at every tier will use a skilled and trained workforce, meaning all workers in an apprenticeable occupation in the building and construction trades are either skilled journeypersons or apprentices registered in a program approved by the Chief of the Division of Apprenticeship Standards of the Department of Industrial Relations ("Chief") and in compliance with the following provisions:

.1 For work performed on or after January 1, 2018, at least 40 percent of the skilled journeypersons employed to perform work on the project by every contractor and each of its subcontractors at every tier are graduates of an apprenticeship program for the applicable occupation.

<u>.2</u> For work performed on or after January 1, 2019, at least 50 percent of the skilled journeypersons employed to perform work on the contract or project by every contractor and each of its subcontractors at every tier are graduates of an apprenticeship program for the applicable occupation.

<u>.3</u> For work performed on or after January 1, 2020, at least 60 percent of the skilled journeypersons employed to perform work on the contract or project by every contractor and each of its subcontractors at every tier are graduates of an apprenticeship program for the applicable occupation.

LABOR COMPLIANCE

- This is a Prevailing Wage project. Certified Payroll Reports will be required.
- This project is subject to 'Skilled & Trained Workforce' requirements. Each Subcontractor shall be responsible for verifying the requirements for their specific trade, and complying with all applicable laws/regulations.
